Here is the monthly Conservation tip.

Did you know that 1.5 million barrels of oil are used every year to manufacture disposable plastic water bottles for the U.S. market? That's enough to fuel 100,000 cars for a year. The bottling process itself uses two gallons of water for every gallon of water it bottles. It's also 240 to 10,000 times more expensive than water from the tap. And bottled water is actually subjected to less rigorous testing and purity standards than tap water here in the U.S. Solution - Invest in a reusable bottle. You'll save money and help save the planet.
