Monthly Meetings

Our Club year runs concurrently with the Forsyth County School System, so our general membership meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of each month, September to May.

We meet in the Three Chimneys Farm Clubhouse and social time begins at 9am and the business meeting usually runs from 9:30am to about 11am. Attendance at general meetings is required to maintain membership status. Only 3 meetings may be missed each Club year.

Service Requirements

Members need 30 service hours on projects led by SWC (or on outside projects sponsored by the Club) each year, including required participation in our annual fundraiser. Financial contributions may also be converted to service hours.

Financial Commitments

Initiation fees and annual dues are set by the Executive Board. Initiation Fees are payable at or before Orientation and Dues are payable in October.

Members must purchase a ticket to our fundraiser and solicit an item for our silent auction (either ask a business for a donation or just give us a check), a combined maximum of \$150.
